Weaving

Instructor/Artist: Ann Lynn Whiteside

We will be weaving a scarf out of wool that has long color changes. The technique is called Clasped weft. It is an easy technique to master and the results are stunning.

Woodturning

Instructor/Artist: Doc Davis

Learn to turn a bowl, make boxes and to do spindle turning, such as candlesticks and pens. Each participant from beginner to experienced turner will work at their own pace and skill level. Bring wood turning tools if you have them. Otherwise, tools will be provided.

Knitting

Instructor/Artist: Kat Ballard

An art form that is fun, versatile, and easy to learn! Beginners will learn the basics on a simple cowl. Intermediate knitters will hone their skills on a leaf-lace pattern cowl.

Independent Study

For those who would like to work alone or with another person without an instructor, e.g. writing, painting, photography etc.

Spinning (Beginner Spinning Class) Instructor Elke Shubert

Spinning is relaxing and fun! Learn about different types of fibers, preparations and selection, how to draft fibers, spin on a hand spindle and spinning wheel, plying and storage.

Students can bring their own spinning wheel – wheel has to be in good working order, or use one supplied by the teacher. Students can also bring other spinning equipment (if they have it already at home) like hand carders, niddy noddy, yarn ball winder, and nostepinne.

Teacher will supply fiber and hand spindle. Supply fee \$15 / student.

Upcycled Art Instructor Ruth Pattison

For a total creative folk art experience gather up a couple of moth eaten woolens and flannel plaids, and some wool sweaters that don't fit anymore and wash them hot and dry them high to shrink them to a perfect pleasing density. Then, come to Camp Mikell and cut and stitch and shape your way to some fanciful Christmas stockings, or if you prefer, a cozy for a French Press or tea kettle. Think outside the box of the Christmas red and green.

We will have notions galore: rick rack, buttons, beads, ribbons, colorful felt squares, embroidery floss and even some extra sweaters.

Bring extras of anything if you want to share. No sewing skills necessary. No sewing machine required, but bring one if you have one.

We will conjure St Nicholas to give some thought as to why we would ever do such a thing as this!
