

# **Camp Mikell**

## **Bus & Van Safety Procedures**

When transporting campers, counselors, and summer staff in vehicles, they shall all understand and obey the following rules.

1. Everyone in vehicles will wear seatbelts. The number of passengers will not exceed the number of seatbelts. This is in compliance with Georgia state law.
2. The number of passengers in a vehicle will not exceed the manufacturers' seating capacity.
3. Campers will not ride in the front seat of the bus or van.
4. Campers need to stay in their seats unless using the restroom in a commercial bus.
5. Campers will not throw anything from the bus or van.
6. Campers will keep all hands, feet, and head in the bus or van at all times.
7. Campers will get on and off the bus or van calmly and orderly.
8. Campers will listen to the driver and the staff member while riding the bus or van.

Note: The Atlanta drop-off & pick-up location is in the parking lot of the Cathedral of St. Philip, 2744 Peachtree Rd, NW, Atlanta, GA. Please be aware of cars, as this is a parking lot with other traffic. In case there is an emergency or change in times or location of pickup or drop-off of campers, the Cathedral will be notified (404-601-5320). This is the Diocesan office number. They will assist in notifying parents of any change. When you drop your child off at the Cathedral, please check in with a Camp Mikell staff member. If your child is riding the bus home, the Camp Mikell staff member aboard the bus will release your child to whomever you listed as the pickup person and get a signature to verify. \*If your child leaves belongings on the bus, you may contact the Mikell office at 706-886-7515 or Daniel's Charters directly at 770-532-6878 or toll free at 1-866-532-6878.
