## **POOL RULES**

- Shower off before you enter the pool
- No running around the pool
- No dead-mans float
- No horseplay
- No chicken fighting
- · No flips, backwards or forwards, off the diving board
- Don't stand on the diving board if someone else is on it. One person on the diving board at a time.
- No one swims in the deep end if others are going off of the diving board. No one on the diving board if the deep end is open for swimming.
- Wait until the person who just went off the diving board reaches either side of the pool or exits before going off the board.
- Do not hang on the rope.
- NO food, drinks, or gum are allowed in the pool area.
- NO cut-off shorts, beads, band-aids, or anything else that could disrupt the filter system are allowed in the pool area.
- All children who are not potty trained will wear swim diapers. Defecation in the pool will cause the pool to be shut down.
- NO open cuts, sores, or anyone with a communicable disease is allowed in the pool.
- The pool area will be left in the same or better condition than it was found. This
  means that any trash will be disposed of properly and all toys, etc., will be put
  away.
- All posted pool rules on the pool house wall will be followed.
- For every 30 people, in addition to the lifeguard, one lookout trained in elementary, non-swimming rescues should be posted.
- For 60+ people you must have an additional lifeguard and/or a lookout posted at each corner of the pool.

The gate will be closed and locked without a lifeguard present. Close and lock gate(s) when you are finished!

No one should come into the gate to the pool without a lifeguard present and ready for swimmers!
